Children's Situation in Japan

- "Child Poor" 1 out of 6 children (about 2.3M children)
- About 600 public and private foster homes/orphanages
- domestic violence, single parents, low income, parent's sickness, disabled children etc.
- About 30,000 children at the age of 2 to 18 living in foster homes
- Only 12% of children in foster homes are adopted.
- College- going rate: national 75% foster homes 20%

Children in foster homes may be lucky.

- Subsidy JKA (2011-2016)/Japan Foundation (2014-2016)
- Sponsors Cerebos (2014, 2016) /Genting (2014)
 "Art is a luxury." "Why I need to pay for fun?"
- Fundraising Event Singapore Embassy in Japan (2015)
- Ticket Sales –21% of total income, 40% of audience pays
- Donation 12,500SGD (ChildAid Asia 2016)
